In addition, I am agreeing to receive internet service from Jackson County REMC.

The location of all existing underground improvements as determined during the Pre-Drop Survey are based upon (in addition to an 811 inspection) aboveground evidence and upon information provided by you. These improvements may include but are not limited to telecommunications cables, waterlines and pipes, electrical lines and conduits, dog fences, drains, downspouts and septic tank and its laterals. JACKSON COUNTY REMC will not be responsible for any damages to any underground improvements on your real estate occurring during the fiber-optic cable installation which were not revealed by an 811 inspection or not disclosed on the attached Pre-Drop Survey. You agree that you will be responsible for and shall defend and indemnify and hold harmless JACKSON COUNTY REMC, and its employees, affiliates, suppliers, agents and contractors and shall reimburse us for any damages, losses or expenses (including without limitation, reasonable attorney's fees and costs) incurred in connection with any claims, suits, judgements and causes of action arising out of any damages caused to an underground facilities or improvements on your real estate not revealed by an 811 inspection conducted pursuant to I.C., 8-1-26 or by the pre-drop survey.

Once broadband internet service is installed, it is your responsibility to take appropriate precautions to secure your own network by installing and maintaining anti-virus and anti-malware software. Jackson County REMC does not assume any responsibility and you are solely responsible for any content stored, accessed, or transmitted using Jackson County REMC broadband internet services.
