Power Cost Adjustment Reset Effective April 1, 2026

Beginning April 1, 2026, Jackson County REMC's Power Cost Adjustment (PCA) will reset as part of the Hoosier Energy, Inc.'s new wholesale power rates.

The PCA reflects the cost Jackson County REMC pays for wholesale electricity from our power supplier, Hoosier Energy, Inc. This charge is adjusted quarterly to reflect changes in fuel costs, market power purchases, and other fluctuating power supply expenses.

Effective April 1, 2026, the PCA will change from \$0.015708 per kWh to \$0.001521 per kWh. This change reflects current wholesale power cost conditions. Because electric bills are based on usage from the prior month, members will begin seeing the impact of these changes on bills issued in May.

Jackson County REMC is a member-owned, not-for-profit cooperative providing electric and broadband services to members throughout our community.
